Sermon Notes

SERMON TITLE: “DIFFERENCE MAKERS: MEN OF FAITH”

SCRIPTURE: Genesis 12:1-4

POINT #1. OBEDIENCE (Compliance, Cooperation, Submission). Obeying God is in our best interest.

POINT #2 OPPOSITION (Difficulties, Enemies, Resistance). Opposition sometimes reveals people’s fear of change.

POINT #3 OPPORTUNITIES (Chance, Freedom, Opening). A seemingly impossible task may be an opportunity for God to work.
